

ALTERNATIVE MOVEMENTS OF ABD EL KRIM'S FORCES

MOVE

DEPLOYMENTS

1	<i>Celebrations outside the besieged town of Hassi BahBah by the Rebel forces who organise themselves and elect leaders.</i>
2	<i>El Krim divides his army: Main Force: 4 warbands of cavalry, 6 spear armed, and 4 rifle armed warbands of infantry move toward Erfoud. Besieging Force: 6 warbands remain to besiege Hassi Bahbah. Strike Force: 6 camel mounted warbands set out for Tanout-Azzal.</i>
3	<i>Strike force arrives to Tanout-Azzal at midday and pushes on after resupply toward El Harach. Main Force arrives to Erfoud.</i>
4	<i>Main Force departs for Hassi Khebi. Strike Force arrives to El-Harach and attacks any French troops there.</i>
5	<i>Strike Force: If defeated by the French, it retires on Hassi Bahbah. If victorious, or there were no French there, it proceeds to Fort Zuassantneuf via El Nooki.</i>
6	<i>Strike Force arrives to El Nooki. Main Force arrives to Hassi Khebi.</i>
7	<i>Main force departs for Fort Zuassantneuf. The cavalry will push ahead to prevent any supplies reaching the fort and begin the siege. Strike Force leaves for Zuassantneuf.</i>
8	<i>Both forces are travelling.</i>
9	<i>Main Force cavalry arrives before the Fort at the end of turn 9. Strike Force arrives at Fort Zuassantneuf.</i>
10	<i>Main Force arrives at Fort Zuassantneuf. The combined army will attack, especially if the garrison is weak or they have captured the supply column.</i>
11	<i>A defeated Main Force would retire back towards Hasi-BahBah the way it had come.</i>
12	<i>If no relief column arrives, Hassi-BahBah falls to Abd El Krims forces and Sheikhi Abdul Abulbul is killed.</i>
